SCALE OF FOODBANK

- 2,283,976 million kg of food distributed to those in need in 2010 (since 1994 over 23 million kgs)
- Regional centres in Albany, Geraldton, Southwest (Bunbury) and Peel and soon Kalgoorlie/Boulder
- 15 full time, 3 permanent part time staff and 180 volunteers.
- A team of 12 disabled permanent part time and casual staff
- During 2010, 317 schools were involved in the School Breakfast Program across metropolitan and regional WA. The program directly reached over 11,000 children and served over 37,000 breakfasts and 11,500 'emergency' meals per week.
